Give each of your chosen modes of transport a score out of ten for each factor.

Mode of transport	Factor 1: Price	Factor 2: Environment	Factor 3: Speed	Factor 4: Comfort	Total (out of 40)
Motorbike	6	5	6	5	22
Horse	6	8	5	2	21
Old car	4	4	5	10	23
Walking	10	10	1	3	24

10 = very good 5 = middle 1 = bad
